Bacteria are the trigger of many complaints and diseases

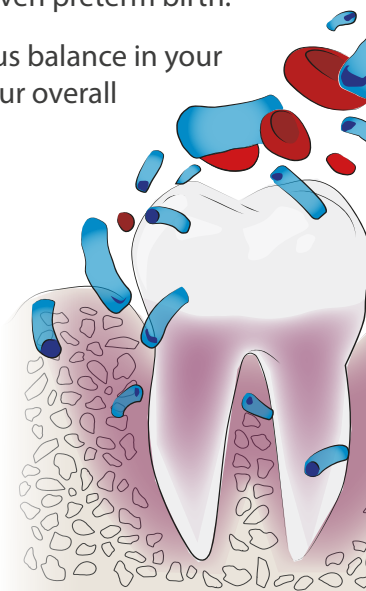
Do you have bleeding gums, fighting gum recession or loose teeth? Perhaps you have lost one or more teeth or maybe you have dental implants?

By developing a harmonious balance in your mouth you can improve your overall health and well being!!

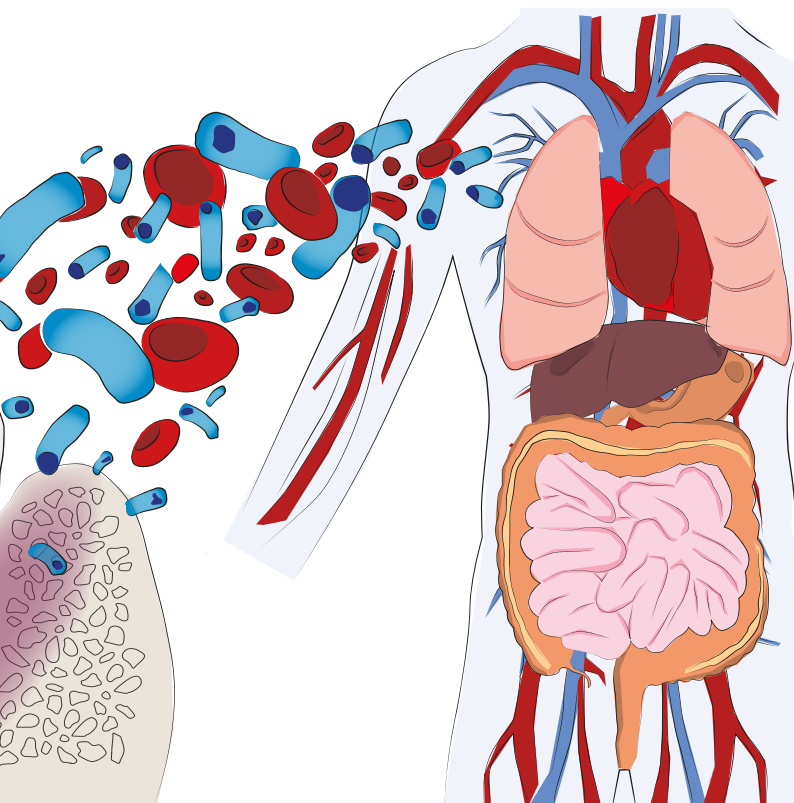

Back to balance with HELBO therapy

These can cause unpleasant side effects, such as gastrointestinal discomfort. In addition, there is a risk that resistant bacteria can develop as a result. Disinfecting rinsing solutions usually only have a superficial effect, they are not sufficiently effective in depth.



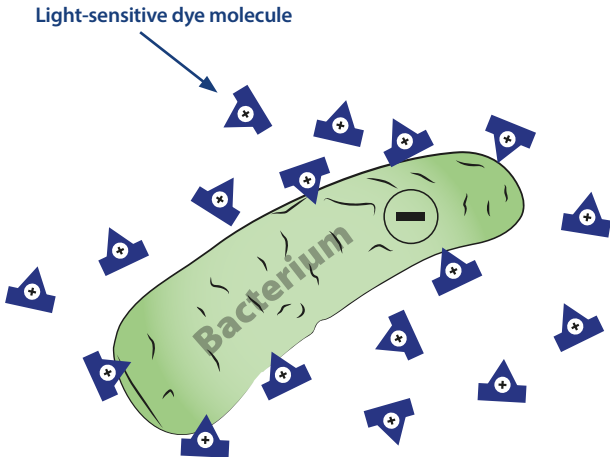

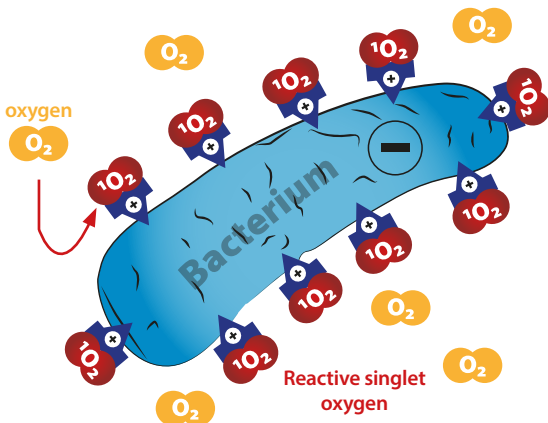

bacteria in the mouth area.



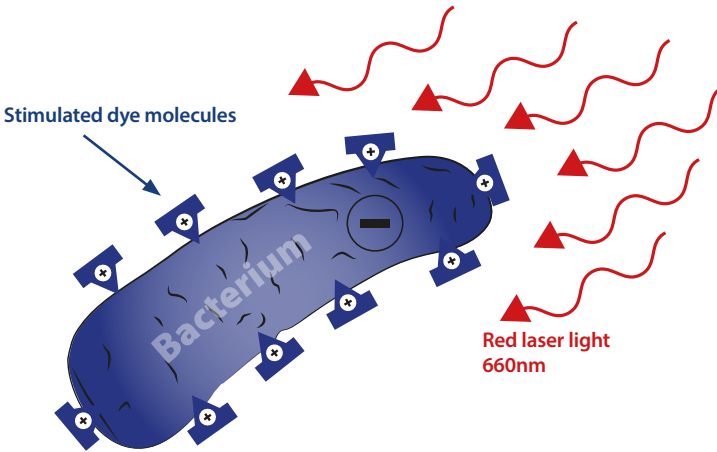
- 1 Selective deposition of light-sensitive dye molecules on the bacterial wall



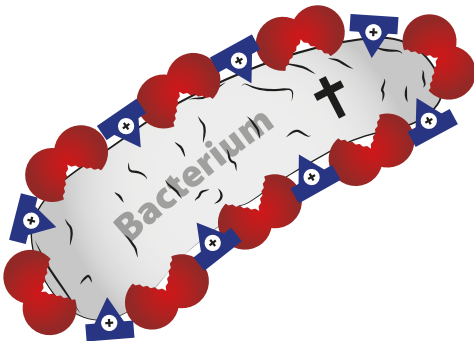
- 3 Reaction with oxygen, formation of highly reactive oxygen

Minimally invasive therapy – Maximum patient benefit

Excitation of a high-dose, light-sensitive dye solution with light of a suitable wavelength and dose results in the formation of aggressive oxygen molecules, which destroy bacteria!

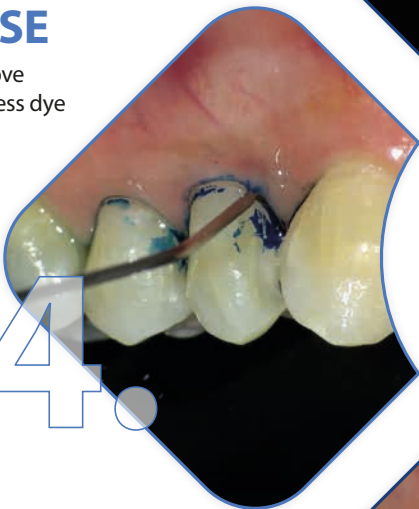

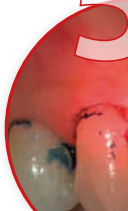

1. CLEAN

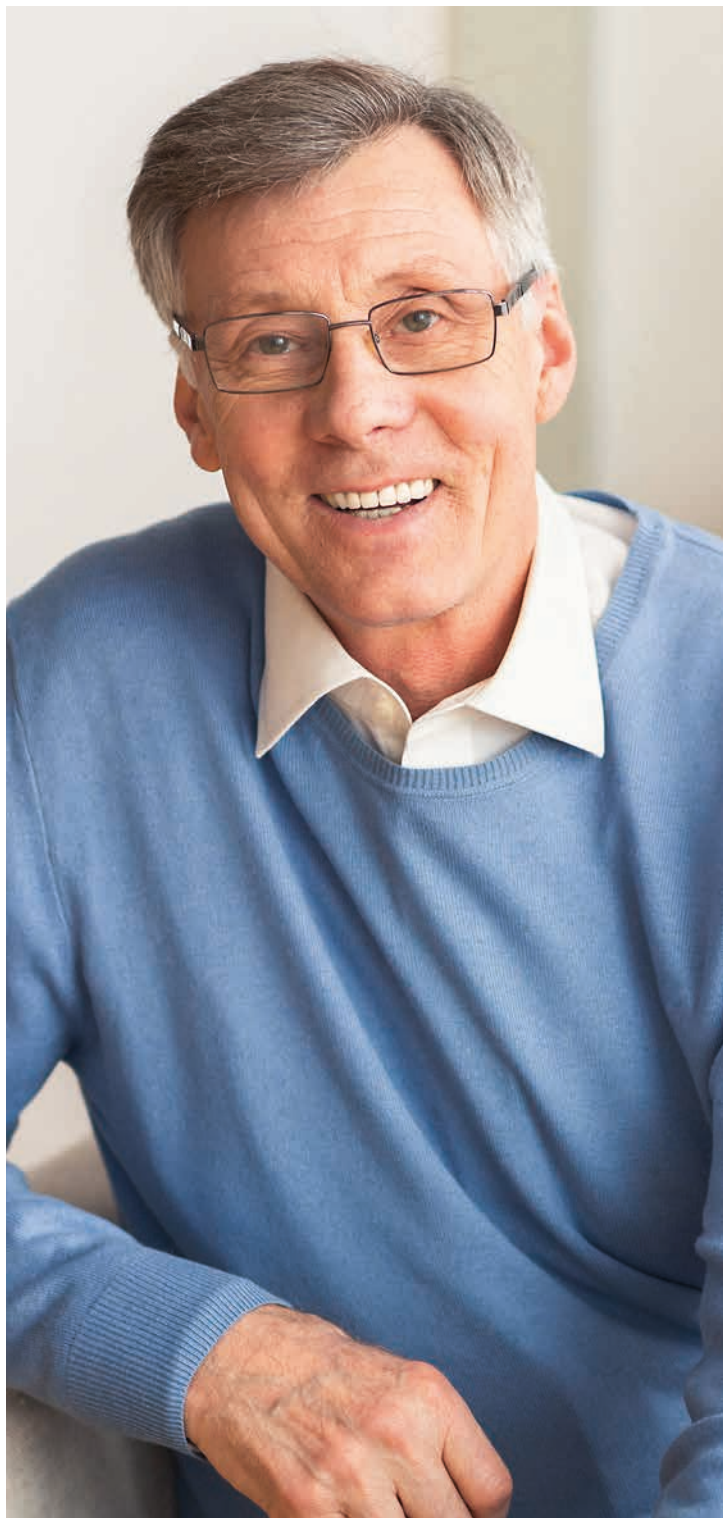
Mechanical removal of hard and soft deposits

Which diseases in the mouth area does HELBO help with?

The therapy can be used for periodontitis (general periodontosis), inflammations around dental implants, infections in the tooth root canal, wound healing disorders, e.g. after surgical interventions or in oral mucosal skin diseases (herpes, aphths).



Do I experience pain during HELBO therapy?

No, it enables painless treatment.



Where does HELBO laser therapy work in my body?

Only the infected area in the mouth is treated - so laser therapy acts purely locally and not throughout the body, unlike antibiotics. This significantly reduces the use of antibiotics.



HELBO therapy uses a dye solution, among other things. Can this cause tooth discolouration?

Temporary staining of rough surfaces, e.g. on teeth, dentures and gums, which the dentist can only remove immediately to a limited extent, cannot be avoided. However, this residual staining usually disappears within two to three hours after treatment and does not pose a problem for eating and drinking.
